CALL FOR ENTRY: MOTHER'S ROOM

Exhibition Description

Mother's Room is an interrogation of space design and its potential to disrupt systems of domination.

Creative professionals from design, social sciences, philosophy, architecture and art are invited to apply. The project will manifest in a body of research, designs for alternative futures, internet art objects and reproducible installations presented on the New Art City exhibition platform.

This project is inspired by architecture -- by a specific room for breastfeeding called the "Mother's Room" at the University where I was lecturing -- and the ways that spaces both reflect and reinforce systemic violence. The project is centered on the idea of space in art as a fielding ground for theoretical discourse. It is also intended to serve as a critique for the way design thinking can either reinforce or disrupt systems of domination.

Though the title includes the word Mother, it is NOT about the gender of the submitter. This is intended to be a wide and inclusive meditation on the idea of space design and its interaction with bodily experience and caregiving.
